Legation, after further reflection, ventures suggestion that our proposal to turn over identifiable Jewish property at Salzburg to IGCR might be inconsistent with our previous liberal policy for restitution of identifiable Hungarian displaced property and with the spirit of Articles 27 and 30 of the Treaty.

Pending the receipt of further instructions Legation shall defer communication with Central Board of Jews on the subject.
