SUBJECT : PROPERTY CONTROL
FROM : PROPERTY CONTROL OFFICER E 2 K 3
TO : COMMANDING GENERAL XV. CORPS for G - 5

A train made up of 52 freight cars stands on the siding at Werfen about thirty miles south of Salzburg.

A party of about 130 Hungarians, men women and children are aboard. Of the 52 cars, 29 are reported by the leader of the Hungarian group, to contain valuables taken from villages and cities of Hungary,

A guard, 24 hours a day, has been posted, supplied by 15th Inf. Regt. 3rd Division, under supervision of Lt. Harwood. Car numbers, of the 29 above mentioned are listed below together with description of purported contents.
